### UIU Benefits for Military and Veterans

- Patriot Grant available to all military personnel (active, guard, reserve, and retired), as well as their family who are Department of Defense ID card holders. Veterans also qualify for the Patriot Grant.
- Credit for your military service (based on Joint Services Transcript).
- Transfer up to 90 semester credits from accredited institutions (max. of 78 lower-division credits) – with C- grade or better.
- Receive \$250 per undergraduate credit hour through the Military Family Grant for all active duty, reserve, National Guard service members, and their eligible spouses and dependents.
- Personal UIU advisor available for consultations.
